ORDINANCE NO. 2

SERIES 1978

An ORDINANCE, providing for the establishment of Fire Lanes upon the streets and public ways within the City of Kingsley; the restriction of parking within said fire lane areas, as indicated on the Plat of the City of Kingsley Streets and Ways, attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, are cross-hatched thereon; and providing penalties for the violation of the provision as set forth:

SECTION I. The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide for fire lanes upon the streets and public ways within the City of Kingsley, for the restrictions of parking or standing of vehicles within said restricted fire lane areas for the protection of the property owner and general public within this City.

SECTION II. As used in this Ordinance, the area designated by cross-hatch upon street and public ways of the City of Kingsley, shall be so designated as Fire Lanes.

SECTION III. As designated in this Ordinance, restricted parking within said fire lanes shall apply to all vehicles actually stopped and parked or standing vehicles within the designated fire lane area.

SECTION IV. As designated by this Ordinance, vehicles shall mean any automobile, truck, motor home, van, motorcycle, bicycle, trailer or any other two, four or additional wheeled vehicle, operating on the public streets or ways or within the City of Kingsley.

SECTION V. It will be the duty of the Marshal, designated Deputy Marshal or authorized Police Officer to advise the enforceability of the violation of this Ordinance either by issuing a warning or a citation, depending upon the circumstances.

SECTION VI. Interference with enforcement prohibited. No person shall in any manner interfere with, hinder, molest or abuse any officer or individual authorized to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION VII.*Penalties. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be given a warning or punished by fine of not less than \$15.00 nor more than \$100.00.

SECTION VIII. The Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval by the Board of Trustees, advertising and publishing according to law.

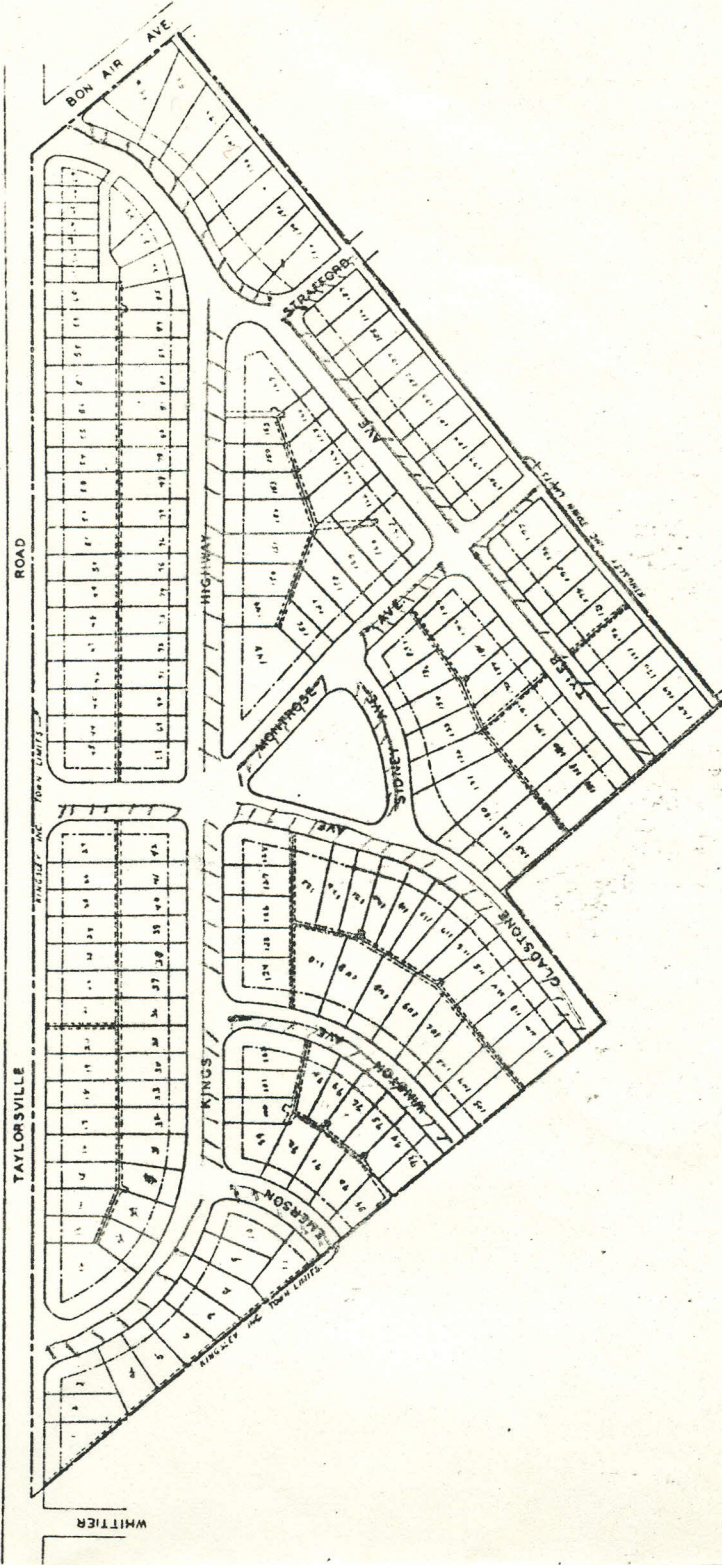
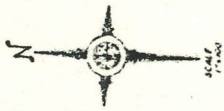
