ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INDEMNIFICATION AND PAYMENT ON BEHALF OF ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY

FOR LOSSES ARISING OUT OF CIVIL ACTIONS

WHEREAS, it has become increasingly difficult to obtain certain types of insurance coverage for the City of Kingsley, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City of Kingsley, Kentucky's elected officials to carry out their respective duties, it is necessary for them to have protection from lawsuits arising from civil actions.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Kingsley, Kentucky does ordain as follows:

 The City shall provide for the defense of any elected official in any action arising out of an act or omission occurring within the scope of his work;

2. The City shall pay any judgment based thereon and/or any compromise settlement of any such action except as provided in subsection 3;

3. The City may refuse to pay a judgment or settlement in any action against an elected official if:

a. The act was outside the apparent scope of his duties; or

b. The elected official willfully refused to assist in the defense of the cause of action.

4. If the City pays any claims or judgment against any elected official pursuant to subsection 2, it may recover against said elected official the amount of said payment, and the costs expended by the City for his defense, if the elected official acted or failed to act because of fraud, malice or corruption.

5. An emergency is declared to exist and there is insufficient time for two (2) readings.
