

ORDINANCE NO. 6, SERIES 1992

CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING NON-PARTISAN ELECTIONS
PURSUANT TO KRS 83A.045, 83A.170 AND 83A.175
WITH ELECTIONS OF CITY OFFICIALS TO BE AT TIME
OF GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Kingsley, Kentucky, have the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is desirable for the City to have 'Non-partisan' elections for the offices of Mayor and City Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, it has also been determined that it is not necessary for the City to conduct a primary election for these positions, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Kingsley, Kentucky, shall elect the Mayor and the legislative body (Commissioners) by non-partisan elections, pursuant to KRS 83A.045, 83A.050 and 83A.170, and

SECTION 2. Elections shall be held at the time of the general election only, and no candidate for mayor or city commissioner position shall be put on the ballot at the time of the primary election.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication, and summary publication is authorized.
