The meeting was called to order at 7:31PM by Mayor Beld

2356 TYLER LANE:

Wind turbines—Maria Cleary e-mailed a corrected address for a home at 1112 Hull St that has had 3 wind turbines attached to its roof. Commissioners who either viewed it online or drove to the location noted the home is in a mixed use/industrial part of Metro Louisville, as opposed to a residential neighborhood such as Kingsley.

The front of this property was camouflaged by large trees. A plan for immediately camouflaging the two turbines at 2356 Tyler from the neighbors on either side is needed. The natural border and size must be approved by the City Commission.

A deadline for completion of the driveway, sidewalks and driveway apron/encroachment is needed.

Metal roof—An ordinance will be created to amend Ordinance #2, Series1940 to remove the ban on metal roofs. They will be acceptable in Kingsley provided the Commission reviews and approves in advance. The second reading will be conducted at the September Commissioners' meeting.

ORDINANCE #6 SERIES 2022:

Finn conducted the first reading of Ordinance #6 Series 2022 An Ordinance Amending Ordinance #2 Series 1940 Relating to Metal Roofs with prior review by the Commission.

WASTE PICKUP:

Yard waste is being picked up every other week through the fall. When the contract is up next June, bid specifications would include weekly yard waste collection, with a clause that credit is to be automatically applied to the monthly bill if unforeseen circumstances create omissions.

ORDINANCE #7 SERIES 2022:

Becky conducted the first reading of Ordinance #7 Series 2022 an Ordinance for the Time and Place of Regular Commissioners' Meeting.
