Kingsley is a Home Rule City within Metro Louisville incorporated in 1939. There are 176 homes. All are zoned single family only. There is a small section zoned for commercial properties. It contains a building with 2 businesses and 2 apartments and a gas/convenience store. We follow Metro ordinances, but the following are the activities and responsibilities that set us apart from Metro:

Garbage/Recycling/Yard Waste/Large Item Pickups –

We contract for these services separately from Metro. Our pick up is on Tuesdays, unless a holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday. Yard waste and trash are picked up every week, recycling is every other week. Details on what waste they'll pick up, the recycle pickup schedule and how to get a large item picked up can be found on the website. Do not put out trash, recycling etc before Monday evening, and bring empty containers back in by Tuesday evening. If you are unable to bring your haulers to the curb, contact us at:

Snow Removal –

We also contract with a company to treat and plow our roads when snow or ice is expected. If snow is predicted, please don't park on the street.

Public Spaces –

We have several traffic islands with decorative plantings we manage with a contracted landscaping company. We also have Kingsley Green Park where you can pick up a book at the Little Library and sit and relax for a bit. While walking your pet on a leash, be sure to pick up any pet waste and dispose of it properly.

Tree Planting –

We will plant a street tree in the easement if funds are available in the budget and if there is space and you are willing to water it for the first couple of years. Check out the website for more details.

Tree Removal –

Please fill out a form found on the website if you want to remove a diseased or dying tree from the easement.

Street Lights –

We contract with LG&E to maintain the street lights in our City. If you see a light out or broken glass, contact LG&E directly—by phone or online. Just have the address of the damaged light before you contact LG&E.

Parking –

We follow Metro's and Land Development rules, but in a nutshell:

--Park in your own garage or driveway. If they are full, then park on the street.

--Do not block the sidewalk.

--Do not park on the driveway apron.

--Park with traffic flow. Observe No Parking signs.

--Park with all four tires on the street.

---Don't park within 30 feet of a STOP sign.

Signage in your Easement –

The only type of sign allowed in the easement is a House For Sale sign immediately in front of the property for sale. Political signs must go in your front yard and be taken down after the election. You may not post signs in any public spaces.

Police Protection –

LMPD and 911 are your first source of police, fire or medical protection in an emergency, but we also contract with Strathmoor Village Police Department for additional neighborhood police services. SVPD can do a house check if you go out of town. They are also available at our city activities, and can often be seen in and around Kingsley watching for traffic violations. Check the website for info on how to request a home check.

Neighborhood Activities –

We have four activities for your family to enjoy:

--Egg Hunt --- Saturday before Easter on Kingsley Green Park

--Yard Sale --- First Saturday in June in your yard

--Kingsley Picnic---A Sunday in mid-September on Kingsley Green Park

--Halloween Celebration---Sunday before Halloween meet at Kingsley Green Park
