Mayor's Comments

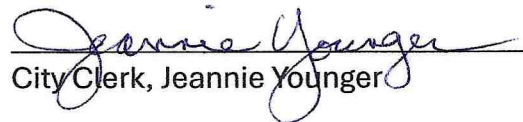
